



2016 Crop Ingredion TRUETRACE® Grower Protocols and Requirements

TRUETRACE® protocols help growers to maintain non GMO purity within acceptable levels. As part of Ingredion's TRUETRACE® program, non GMO corn growers will be required to:

- Clean and to provide documented proof of cleaning for all equipment along the supply chain including:
 - Planters
 - Combines
 - Trucks
 - Wagons
- Clean and to provide documented proof of cleaning for storage and corn handling facilities
 - Dryers
 - Bins
- Avoid non GMO corn from a field that was planted with GMO corn in the previous year
- Maintain documentation of non GMO seed purchases
- Provide maps highlighting the location of the corn being grown
- Keep representative samples of non GMO corn identified by storage bin and be willing to submit these samples at Ingredion's request
- Keep corn rows that are bordering GMO corn separate from the non GMO corn program
 - If GMO corn is being grown within 160 feet (50 meters), 16 bordering rows are to be excluded from the non GMO corn program
 - If GMO corn is being grown within 600 feet (183 meters), 8 bordering rows are to be excluded from the non GMO corn program
- Complete a sustainability survey
